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What does the Community Children's Nursing Team do?

A community children's nurse (CCN) is a registered nurse with special qualification for working with children.

A CCN works in partnership with parents and other health care professionals to ensure that the health care needs of sick children are met, for example, with:

Paediatric consultants Nurse specialists GP's Health visitors Social workers Physiotherapists Occupational therapists Dieticians

The CCN can provide support, guidance and education for a variety of medical conditions and needs, including:

After surgery care – wound care Asthma or other respiratory conditions Eczema Cardiac conditions Gastrostomy care Constipation Nasogastric tube care Taking bloods

Where is the service provided?

The service provides home-based nursing care for children between the ages of 0–18 years.

Children can also be seen in a variety of convenient locations; either schools, hospitals or local clinics.

The Community Children's Nursing Team is based in two localities, covering both Taw and Torridge geographical areas of North Devon and can be contacted by telephone or mobile telephone.
